Schedule: This position is planned for a 28 hour work week with a flexible schedule.

Qualifications: Children's ministry experience preferred, however will consider

comparable experience in child and family development. Minimum of bachelor's degree preferred but will consider commensurate experience.

This is a nonordained position.

Accountability: Serves as staff liaison with Children's Ministry Commission. Relates

directly to the Senior Pastor/Head of Staff and Personnel Commission for

support and accountability.

<u>Position Overview:</u> This position will primarily focus on ministry with and to children and

families from birth through 5th grade with the following priorities:

- Fostering Genuine Community
- Leadership Recruitment and Development
- Engaging Parents as Partners in Ministry
- Service Opportunities and Service as a Way of Life

Responsibilities: Every candidate will bring a unique mix of gifts and passions that will
