THE PURPOSE OF PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN

To build an inclusive, caring community of women that strengthens the Presbyterian Church (USA) and witnesses to the promise of God's kingdom.

OUR PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN'S SYMBOL

The circle, with its leaves reaching outward, represents the church worldwide, where women offer their gifts and talents in the midst of the global community.

The three figures, with no distinctive features, represent women of all ages and racial/ethnic backgrounds, a community of women in Christ. As for "the forgiven", these women rising from the Bible illustrate serving, studying, and praising God. The design suggests a triangle within a circle - Trinity and Unity.

MISSION PLEDGE OFFERING

Over and above her pledge to the local church, each woman who is a member of PW will be encouraged to give through her Circle. The monthly monies will support the worldwide mission of the church and the basic operating budget of PW at the congregation, presbytery, synod and churchwide levels.

BIRTHDAY OFFERING

As recognition of our heritage, we are challenged to give one penny for each year of our lives as a "Birthday Gift." This offering collected each March and dedicated at the Spring Presbytery Gathering, goes to new and innovative worldwide mission projects.

THANK OFFERING

As recognition of God's blessing to us, we collect this gift in the September and dedicate it at the Fall Presbytery Gathering. 40% goes to support worldwide medical mission. 60% will be used for new creative areas of mission.

THE FELLOWSHIP OF THE LEAST COIN

Women everywhere give the "least coin" of their country as a visible symbol of our oneness in Christ as we pray for peace and reconciliation in the family, the community, the nation, and the world. Grants are made for projects of evangelism, service, and relief. This is collected monthly at all Circle meetings.
